Autism is a lifelong developmental disability which affects how people communicate and interact with the world. One in 100 people are on the autism spectrum and there are around 700,000 autistic adults and children in the UK.

When a student is diagnosed with ASC we work collaboratively with parents / carers, CAMHS and our Clinical Psychologist to look at strategies for supporting students at school.

We then use the following to support the student at school:

- Social Skills Group
- ELSA
- Speech and Language Therapy
- Sensory Room
- In class support through quality first teaching methods including scaffolding, retrieval practice and chunking learning.
- Use of now and next task boards.
